#### **Used Household Goods and Personal Effects**

# **Documents Required**

- Passport
- Letter from the Ministry of Foreign Affairs
- Original bill of lading (OBL) / air waybill (AWB)

#### **Specific Information**

- A foreigner may import household goods and personal effects duty free under the following conditions:
  - They have diplomatic status or work for an NGO
  - A letter is obtained from the Ministry of Foreign Affairs verifying the owner of the goods' diplomatic status or employment with an NGO and requesting Customs to permit duty-free import
- The owner of the goods do not have to be present for Customs clearance, however, the owner of the goods'
  employer must be registered and issue a letter on company letterhead stating that the owner of the goods is
  employed in Cambodia.

#### **Motor Vehicles**

# **Documents Required**

Passport

- OBL
- Letter from the Ministry of Foreign Affairs
- · Letter from the Ministry of Finance

### **Specific Information**

- A foreigner may import a motor vehicle under the following conditions:
  - They have diplomatic status or work for an NGO
  - A letter is obtained from the Ministry of Foreign Affairs verifying the owner of the goods' diplomatic status or employment with an NGO and requesting Customs to permit duty-free import.
- All automobiles must be left-hand drive.

#### **Pets**

#### **Documents Required**

- Vaccination record
- · Veterinary health certificate

## **Specific Information**

- Most pets, including dogs, cats and birds, can be imported with no quarantine period required.
- The health certificate must be issued within 7 days of import.

#### Restricted/Dutiable Items

- · Human remains and body parts
- Firearms, weaponry and their parts
- · Perishable food items
- Live animals (some species / breeds permitted; contact agent for details)
- Plant and plant materials

#### **Prohibited Items**

- Batteries
- Acids, chemicals, corrosives, gases, infectious substances, oxidizers, radioactive substances, etc.
- Flammable substances

- Alcohol
- Perfumes
- Poisons
- Tobacco
- Paints
- Pornographic materials

# **Consignment Instructions**

**Recommended:** Contact the destination agent to ensure all requirements have been met prior to import, especially for differences regarding air / sea shipments.
